Dr. John Wilson is an Associate Professor of Neurosurgery at the Wake Forest University School of Medicine in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. He received his undergraduate degree at Pennsylvania State University in 1980 and completed his medical degree at Jefferson Medical College in 1982.

His research interests include cerebrovascular disease, aneurysms, and complex spinal disorders. John is currently researching hypothermia in aneurysm surgery, outcomes in spinal surgery, carotid endarterectomy in patients with contralateral carotid occlusion and EC-IC bypass.
